Privacy Notice

Your privacy is a primary concern to us at New Pilgrims UCC (dba for Pilgrim Congregational Church UCC). Our goal in stating our policy on the collection and use of visitor data is to ensure the highest level of confidentiality and security. When you provide information to New Pilgrims UCC (such as name, address, phone number, company name, or event information requests) we will not give or sell your information to any outside organization for its use in marketing or solicitation. We will maintain the confidentiality of your information and it will be used only to communicate about the activities of New Pilgrims UCC.

Our intention is to send e-mail only to individuals who we believe have chosen to receive such e-mails. At any time, you have the right to "opt out" of receiving future New Pilgrims UCC communications by replying to an email with "Remove" or emailing newpilgrimsucc@gmail.com with that request. Your email will be immediately removed from our website subscriber and regular email database.

With whom we may share your data

New Pilgrims UCC may share your personal data with people within our New Pilgrims UCC organization for administrative or legal reasons, for example, to direct a query that you have submitted to the relevant person within the New Pilgrims UCC community.

Our employees and volunteers may use personal devices to access our systems containing your personal data, thus your personal data may be transferred through or to service providers who contract with our employees for cellular data, for example.

We may be required to share your personal data in order to comply with a court order, law, or legal process, including to respond to government or regulatory requests. We may share your personal data to protect the safety of New Pilgrims UCC, our members or others; or to prevent injury to or interference with, our rights or property, or the rights or property of other processors or anyone else that could be harmed by such activities.

Security

New Pilgrims UCC takes reasonable technical and security measures to protect personal data from accidental or unlawful destruction, accidental loss and unauthorized access, destruction, misuse, modification or disclosure.

Records Retention

We will keep your personal data for as long as we need it for the purposes set out above, and so this period will vary depending on your interactions with us. Please note that where you unsubscribe from our communications, we will keep a record of your email address to ensure we do not send you marketing emails in future.

Accessing and Correcting your Information

Keeping your information accurate and up-to-date is very important. Inaccurate or incomplete information could impact our ability to deliver information to you. Please let us know about any

Non-Personal data Information & Cookies

Non-Personal data information

New Pilgrims UCC will have no liability for and will be free to copy, disclose, distribute, incorporate and otherwise use the Communications and all data, images, writings, ideas, suggestions or enhancements, as well as anything embedded therein.

Cookies

In general, you may visit the Site without telling New Pilgrims UCC who you are or revealing personal information about yourself. However, New Pilgrims UCC and companies providing services to or on behalf of New Pilgrims UCC may use various technologies, such as cookies and web beacons (1x1 pixels), to collect non-personal information discernible as a result of your visit. Cookies are used to collect general usage and volume statistical data.
